Why this program

The Privilège Student Ventures Sprint is a condensed, hands-on program designed for students who want to understand **how startups are built, valued, and funded** from both investors' and founders' perspectives.

You will learn how venture capitalists think, how to assess early-stage startups, how innovation creates real economic value and what it means to be a founder or an investor in startups.

What you will learn

- How venture capital works (from sourcing to investment decisions)
- How to value startups: problem, market, product, team & traction
- How investors assess risk and long-term potential
- How founders raise capital and negotiate terms with investors
- How to present your startup clearly through investment memos and pitches
